## COLORING BOOK MINISTRY


### CC Merrit Island

Since its beginning in 1998, The Good News Coloring Book has been used by many Calvary Chapels and other ministries to spread the Gospel around the world. More than 500,000 of these Gospel "tracts" have been distributed to more than 40 countries, and the list keeps growing.

The coloring book uses only Scripture verses to tell the story of Jesus Christ. Key passages have been illustrated to appeal to children, who can then share them with

unsaved parents. The use of Scripture alone has made the coloring book easy to translate. Verses are copied exactly as they appear in the foreign New Testament. The verses are then checked by native speakers to ensure accuracy.

The format makes it easy to reproduce these books on 11x17 paper, and most languages can be downloaded from the website. Currently the book has been translated into Arabic, Bemba, Cebuano, Chinese, Creole, Dutch, English, Fijian, Finnish, French, German, Hungarian, Icelandic, Indonesian,

Isnag, Italian, K'ekchi', Kosrean, Korean, Luganda, Malagasy, Marshalese, Miskito, Munukutuba, Norwegian, Papua New Guinea Pidgin, Polish, Portuguese, Romanian, Russian, Sepik Iwam, Spanish, Swahili, Swedish, Tagalog, Thai, Ukrainian, and Vietnamese. More languages are added monthly.



# CC WEST COVINA

**CC West Covina travels to the Tecate area of Baja California, Mexico to minister to an orphanage and two communities of Mixteco Indians one weekend every month.**

As the church had prayed for outreach opportunities, they felt led to the Mixteco Indians who work as field laborers in Baja California. The large families stay in abandoned chicken coops. The Indians were originally from southern Mexico. The CC West Covina team stays at the nearby mission orphanage, which is home to handicapped children.

They discovered a local missionary caring for 200 children at the camp. Abandoned chicken coops house the 1,800 adults and children. CC West Covina has been able to teach the children about Jesus and share His love. The youngsters are bathed, clothed, and fed. The church provides free haircuts, especially necessary because of the lice problem. Adults are given clothes and gift bags that include toothpaste, toothbrushes, snacks, diapers, and Bible tracts. On the last trip, 60 adults received the Lord.

CC West Covina is praying for a medical outreach to this camp, as the migrants will only be there until December. CC West Covina is looking for others wishing to assist.

# THE JESUS FILM PROJECT

“Our church wanted to be about the Father’s business and to fulfill the Great Commission in a proactive way,” said Chester Hudspeth, missions’ coordinator at CC Mission Viejo, CA (CCMV). “We decided that adopting a people group would challenge us financially and prayerfully—something we could all have ownership in, from Sunday school through church leadership,” Chester explained.

The goal became a reality in May of this year when CCMV partnered with The Jesus Film Project to meet the spiritual needs of the 265,000 minority people known as the Hmong of East Asia. A one-year pledge from CCMV produced the film and audio/radio materials in the language of this unreached people group. The pledge financed a long-term distribution which will begin this fall.

Now in its final stages, Hudspeth said this project met all ministry-related objectives, as well as strengthened congregational faith. “When you have a vision, and believe it is of the Lord, He will allow you to do it.”
