






Footsteps of the Flock

This brand-new book of 365 daily meditations from Joshua to Malachi encourages believers to walk closely beside the Shepherd. Each daily Scripture


with its personal application demonstrates how the Old Testament foreshadows the believer's New Testament hope in Christ.

The First Six Days

How does one confront the "God-plus-evolution" creation myth? Some are erroneously teaching that the six days of creation in the Book of Genesis were not literal days—rather, that evolution occurred during that time frame. Author Douglas Hamp builds a case for taking the biblical account literally—that God created the world in six literal, 24-hour days.

The author uses internal evidence from the Bible itself—including a study of the Hebrew words—as well as external evidence

from geological science, historical and Jewish commentators, and other sources, to debunk misconceptions concerning creation and evolution. He also explores the existence of dinosaurs using scientific evidence and Biblical texts.

Several helpful appendices allow for deeper study, including recommended resources, biblical references to numbers and literal days, and the order of creation versus evolution. Douglas Hamp is an assistant pastor at CC Costa Mesa where he teaches at both the School of Ministry and Graduate School. Paperback, 214 pages, photographs included.
